Unlike rage and hatred, which lead to the destruction of oneself and the Other, anger is both a re/constructive emotion, a survival strategy, a springing source of energy, a dive into oneself, a process of transformation as well as an open universal library to inform action. My premise is that the purpose of anger is the emancipation of being. Thus, the symbolic gesture and the concrete action of emancipation are similar to the marooning of people of African descent enslaved in Abya Yala (Americas), freeing themselves from slavery and cruelty, to re/create their being-in-the-world in a structurally colonial and racist world. In their peregrinations in hostile lands, these women and men have made maroonage a double decolonial perspective: resistance (refusing all oppression) and resilience (reweaving/recreating the links destroyed by coloniality).

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
