It would be difficult for a country to be considered democratic if there had never been a national debate about the essential norms that should govern its life in community. Although historiography has been elusive in addressing this issue, it can be affirmed that the gestation, drafting and elaboration of constitutional charters in republican Chile lack constituent processes of a democratic nature, as a constituent power of popular sovereignty. The same is true in most countries.
